

# UNIVERSITY OF LOUISVILLE SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

The University of Louisville, Department of Equine Administration, will provide four \$1,000.00 per year scholarships (4 years total, not to exceed \$4,000.00) to finalists competing in the Eastern National 4-H Horse Roundup in the following contests:

- Individual Demonstration (1 award)
- Team Demonstration (2 awards)
- Public Speaking (1 award)

The scholarships will be held in an account to be used by individual recipients enrolling at the University of Louisville and actively pursuing a B.S. Degree in Equine Administration. Contest superintendents will submit the names of the Eastern National 4-H Horse Roundup communication contest scholarship winners to the University of Louisville, Department of Equine Administration. Scholarship recipients must enroll in Equine Administration. It is the recipient's responsibility to contact the University of Louisville, Department of Equine Administration, by the fall of the year of application.

The topic of the demonstration or public speaking presentation must incorporate the usage of any business principle including marketing, finance, management, computer information systems, economics, accounting or administration as applied to a horse-related project. Examples of topics can include, but are not limited to: Financial Comparison of Parasite Control Programs; Marketing the Sales of Horses; Economics of Pasture Management Practices; Promotion Strategy for Horse Produce or Feed Product; Planning and Production of a 4-H Horse Show; Management of Security Procedures for Horse Show Drug Testing Programs; Economic Comparison of Fence Materials; Inventory Management Systems for an Equine Veterinary Practice, etc.

The scholarships are to be awarded to the best of the demonstrations and public speeches relating to the specific topic area in the top five finishes. Example: If the highest-placing demonstration selected is not related to the topic area, but the second-highest placing is on the topic area, that demonstration would be eligible for the scholarship.
